



OH&S POLICY

It is the Company policy to take a positive attitude to continually improve the health, safety and welfare of all its employees and where appropriate the general public, through the following and monitoring of this Policy.

- Reviewing and revising this policy annually.
- Provides a framework for setting the Health and Safety Objectives.
- Includes a commitment to eliminate hazards and reduce Health and Safety risks.

The Engineering Manager has delegated responsibility for standards of health and safety throughout the organisation and the following of the policy. The Managers are responsible for the effective implementation of the Policy and are supported in this task by the Health and Safety Consultant.

The Company comply with all relevant legislation and appropriate codes of practice and communicates with relevant agencies and consultative bodies, placing the importance of Health and Safety first at all times.

The Company expect employees to conform to this policy and to comply with the relevant sections of the Health and Safety at Work Act 1974 and to exercise all reasonable care for their own health and safety and that of others who may be affected by their acts or omissions.
